Nepal (FFLN), as it served over 10,000 children across 26

community schools in Tokha and Budhanilkantha municipalities.

FFLN has been a light of hope, providing over 3.7 million nutritious meals since its inception to date, all prepared with locally sourced ingredients. The program has played a crucial role in combating malnutrition and fostering the holistic development of children. The mid-day meals program of Food for Life Nepal has positively impacted school attendance and contributed to reduced drop-out rates. FFLN's focused efforts on vulnerable communities in these municipalities have ensured equal access to education and nutrition through its dedicated flagship Mid-Day Meal Program, contributing to the achievement of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Food for Life Nepal's impact in 2023 went beyond simply filling empty stomachs. It nurtured hope, empowered communities, and paved the way for a more equitable and sustainable future for the children of Tokha and Budhanilkantha.
